
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Developing NavCare-EU:

RESEARCH OBJECTIVE

We aim to develop NavCare-EU and evaluate its effectiveness and cost-effectiveness to improving quality of life of older people with cancer and their families in different healthcare systems in Europe.



METHODOLOGY

NavCare-EU is based on the successfully-tested Nav-CARE program from Canada and will be evaluated in a pragmatic randomized controlled trial in six EU countries.
